ROTTEVEEL VERMEER 荷蘭藝術雙人組，由視覺藝術家 Jochem Rotteveel 與時尚造型師 Thomas Vermeer 於 2021 年組成，因對色彩的共同熱情展開合作。以貼膜與膠帶為主要媒材，融合繪畫與雕塑特質，兩人共同探討色彩、空間與觀看的界限，並向 Rothko、Mondriaan、Yves Saint Laurent 等色彩大師致敬。

透過摺疊與光影效果，在平面中建構立體感，並以光學混色挑戰感知經驗。牆面創作則因展期結束而消失，質疑藝術的永恆性，強調藝術的當下性與觀看瞬間的價值。

Jochem Rotteveel 是一位荷蘭視覺藝術家，專注以膠帶與貼膜創作抽象作品。他將這些非傳統材料視為繪畫工具，發展出獨特的創作語言，結合色域與硬邊繪畫的形式語彙，探索材質、色彩與空間的邊界。

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ROTTEVEEL VERMEER is a Dutch artist duo formed in 2021 by Jochem Rotteveel and fashion stylist Thomas Vermeer, united by a shared passion for color. Coming from contemporary art and fashion backgrounds, they naturally merge their disciplines using adhesive foil and tape, and create on dibond panel—blending painting and sculpture to explore the boundaries of color, material, and space. Their work pays tribute to color masters like Rothko, Mondriaan, Yves Saint Laurent, and Josef Albers, while embracing the experimental spirit of Rauschenberg and Isa Genzken.

By folding flat materials to create volume, they blur the line between two- and three-dimensional space. Instead of physical color blending, they achieve optical effects through light and viewer perception. Their site-specific wall works are dismantled after each show, questioning the need for permanence in art and emphasizing the value of the moment of seeing.

Jochem Rotteveel

Born in 1976 in The Hague, Jochem Rotteveel is a visual artist based in Rotterdam. He holds an MFA from the Royal Academy of Art, The Hague. Using adhesive foil and tape as his main materials, he creates abstract works that explore the boundaries of color, material, and space.

Thomas Vermeer

Born in 1984 in Zwolle, Thomas Vermeer is a fashion stylist based in Amsterdam. A graduate of the Amsterdam Fashion Institute, he has worked with brands like Hermès and Longchamp. His sharp eye for color and material extends into his collaborative art practice with Rotteveel.
